• Attainment

S5 – Best performance ever in SQA examination results, Holy Rood significantly outperforming the virtual comparator school with S4 results.

• Learning opportunities available for S5/6 pupils:-

- School based courses from course option choice.
- College based courses offered in the travel column, potential application to be discussed with Year Head during course choice interview. This can be combined with school based courses.
- Courses at neighbourhood schools as per need e.g. Higher Spanish, Higher Urdu (reciprocal agreement whereby pupils also come here to do courses)
- Work experience placements in travel column, in agreement with Year Head. As an alternative to a school based course or as work experience required for university.

• Explanation of terms

- ➤ Levels
 - National 4, National 5, Higher , Advanced Higher
- Course

A group of units <u>plus</u> an external exam (notional 160 hours programmed learning for National 4,5, Higher) To achieve a COURSE AWARD pupils must complete and PASS <u>all</u> of the SQA units for the course and complete the course assessment – final exam in May/June. Some courses might also have a course project/assignment as part of the course award. COURSE AWARD = Grade A, B, C, D. National 4 courses have **no final exam** and are internally assessed (Pass/fail).

SQA unit of work

Most National Courses from National 2 to Higher are comprised of three Units. These units are assessed by the class teacher using SQA assessment standards. Unit result = PASS/FAIL

• Monitoring Pupil Progress

- > S4 Progress Reports in Oct & Feb, S4 Parents' Evening in Nov, Prelims in Jan.
- > S5/6 Progress Reports in Oct & Mar, S5/6 Parents' Evening in Dec, Prelims late Jan.
- > Must pass all units and the exam to pass the course.
- Grades A, B, C, D based on performance in final exam only. The certificate will show all units and courses passed (Units can be carried forward)

• Moving Forward – Session 2016/17

- > Pupils should select 5 courses to study in S5.
- > Pupils should select $\underline{4}$ or $\underline{5}$ courses to study in S6.
- > Option sheets issued w/b 18 Jan to be returned no later than 29 Jan.
- > Options can be changed if SQA results require this.
- Discussion with Year Head about choices and any other learning opportunities which might be appropriate for the individual pupil.
