## **Sighthill Campus**

### **Automotive Skills**

**Level- National 4**

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This route is designed to engage and motivate SCP learners who are interested in learning about the automotive retail industry. It is ideal for students who wish to undertake a qualification which will support their progress to a Level 1 qualification.

### **Electrical Skills**

**Level- National 5**

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

If you want to become an electrician this course provides the perfect platform to develop your skills and knowledge. You will learn hand skills and wiring techniques which are based around a domestic setting.

### **German**

**Level 5 and 6**

**Days –** Tues and Thurs

This course aims to continue the progressive development of your knowledge and competence of German language by extending the range and complexity of the language encountered.

Higher Modern Languages courses enable learners to read, listen, talk and write in a modern language. Learners also develop language skills of translation.

### **Spanish**

**Level – 5, 6 and 7**

**Days –** Tues and Thurs

This course will continue your development and knowledge of Spanish through increased exposure time to the language. This will give you the opportunity to acquire greater fluency flexibility accuracy and confidence.

## **Digital Media Editing**

**Level-** National 5

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course introduces the processes involved in making and editing films, radio programmes and stills. You will cover idea development, pre-production planning and postproduction.

## **Photography**

**Level- National 5 & Higher**

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course helps students to develop their knowledge and understanding of practical photography. Ideal for those who want to explore their interest in photography and take it to an advanced level.

## **Psychology**

**Level-** Higher

**Requirements** – Higher English and one other Higher Social subject

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

Studying Psychology will enable you to develop an understanding of the human mind and behaviour in a range of contexts, and will enhance your ability to use evidence to explain behaviour.

## **Skills for Work National 5 Retailing**

The aim of this course is to develop the essential skills required to work in retail including team working, problem solving, communication and customer care skills. Candidates are encouraged to set personal goals and develop skills for reviewing and evaluating experience

## **Travel and Tourism: Get Ready for Work**

**Level-** National 5

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course will develop your knowledge of tourist destinations and customer service, preparing you for employment or further education in the industry

## **Advanced Higher French**

**Days** – Tues PM

Continue your development of French through increased exposure time to the language to give you the opportunity to acquire greater fluency, flexibility and accuracy

## **Midlothian Campus**

### **Introduction to Motor Vehicle Industry and Technologies - IMI Entry Level 3 Certificate**

**Level-** National 3

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course will suit you if you are thinking about working in the automotive sector. You will study a range of motor vehicle systems and parts including: engines, cooling, lubrication, fuel, electrical, brakes, wheels, tyres and health and safety in the workplace

### **Engineering Skills**

**Level-** National 5

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

Get the skills base needed in manufacture and process. You will develop the skills and knowledge necessary for basic engineering processes and maintenance, working on a range of engineering systems.

## **Milton Road Campus**

### **Creative Industries Academy (SESAP) Film and Media NPA (QMU)**

**Level-** Higher

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course offers students an introduction to training for a career in film and media. Students will watch and analyse films, explore the role of storytelling in different media, write feature articles, compile a photography portfolio and make their own video.

### **Introduction to Computer Games and Software Development**

**Level-** National 5

**Days-** Fri PM

This course takes students through digital creation skills in a computer games context. It includes an introduction to programming skills and digital media asset creation

### **Music Technology**

**Level-** National 5

**Days –** Tues PM

This course will allow you to develop skills in recording, from using the correct equipment to editing the final product. You will apply and develop your creative skills, as well as gaining wider skills in a related area. This course can be combined with Music Business (SCP), if pupils wish to do so. Please note that this course is only open to pupils from the Forrester High School cluster in the West of Edinburgh.

## **Music Business**

**Level – 6**

**Days - Tues and Thurs**

This course will give you an introduction to different areas of the music business and help you decide if you would like to study and eventually work in this area when you leave school. You will learn about the UK music industry today and how artists are promoted and will also complete a related project.

## **Introduction To College for Schools**

**Level-** National 1-3

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course is designed for pupils who are attending a special school or attending a mainstream school with support. Pupils will be working at level 1 - 4 but may require support. This course will help to build confidence and understanding to assist with course choice. Introduction To College for Schools is also suitable as a post school option for pupils.

## **Play and Child Development (Some Friday afternoon placements required)**

**Level- National 4**

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM some Friday placements required

This course will introduce you to the skills that are required for working with children or studying childcare or social care after you leave school

## **Creative Industries Academy (SESAP) Acting & Performance and Professional Theatre Preparation NPA (QMU) Higher**

**Level-** Higher

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course is being offered through the Creative Academies. The academy gives young people the opportunity to study at school, college and university to gain a unique qualification. You will have the opportunity to achieve an NPA in Acting and Performance or Film and Media

## **Health & Social Care Academy (SEASAP) (QMU) National 5 & Higher (need national 5 Biology)**

**Level –** National 5 and Higher

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This Academy is specifically for senior phase school pupils. The course gives you the opportunity to achieve a relevant qualification in Health and Social Care. It will allow you to develop the necessary skills for entry to college, university or employment.

### **Creative Hairdressing and Make-Up Trends**

**Level** – National 3

**Days** – Tuesday PM

Learn skills in basic make-up application and manicure within our beauty department and in our hairdressing department you will learn how to plait, shampoo and condition hair.

### **Hospitality & Tourism Academy (SESAP) Events with Hospitality (QMU)**

**Level-** Higher

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

The aim of this course is to provide students with the educational knowledge and relevant work experience to prepare them for a career in hotel or restaurant management, customer services, marketing and public relations, or events organisation and management

### **Introduction to Events Co-ordination**

**Level-** National 5

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course is for students looking to develop skills required to work within the Events industry. There is an emphasis on teamwork where you will engage with others, increase your confidence, and improve your communication and selling skills.

### **Professional Cookery NPA**

**Level-** National 3

**Days-** Full day Friday – 9am- 4pm

This is a 1 day SCQF Level 3 course aimed at school pupils who have an interest of becoming a professional chef. The course is an introduction to professional cookery and is designed to allow progression to a full-time Level 1 course in professional cookery at college

### **Acting performance and professional Theatre NPA**

**Level- 6**

**Days-** Tues and Thurs

This course is being offered through the Creative Academies. The Academy gives young people the opportunity to study at school, college and university to gain a unique qualification and range of experiences and aims to help students make an informed choice for future options after school. The Academy gives you the opportunity to achieve a National Progression Award (at SQCF Level 6; Higher level) in Acting and Performance or Film and Media.

### **Film and Media**

Level 6

Days- Tues and Thurs

The NPA in Film and Media will give you an insight into working in areas such as film, publishing, TV, radio and the visual arts. The course is made up of a mixture of practical and theoretical units. You'll have fun, learn new skills, explore different creative media and meet and work with other like-minded young people. The qualification will support applications to college or university courses in related subjects.

### **Studio Recording**

Level 5

Days – Tues and Thurs

This course will allow you to develop skills in recording, from using the correct equipment to editing and final product. You will apply and develop your creative skills, as well as gaining wider skills in a related area.

## **Granton Campus**

### **Computer Games and Software Development**

**Level-** Higher

**Days-** Tues and Thurs PM

This course takes students through programming and media creation for computer games and includes a substantial games project

### **Skills for Work Construction Craft**

**Level-** National 4

**Days -** Full day Tuesday (9am- 4pm)

This course gives S4/5 pupils a chance to try a variety of trade disciplines with a focus on employability skills gained by working with construction companies and visiting building sites.
