Thank you for engaging so well with your learning since the school closed on 20th March. We realise that this may be a challenging time for you and your family and appreciate the effort you are making to do your very best. In the meantime, here is some important information to share with you.

Moving Learning On

As you know, today learning will move on for almost all pupils, although S2 will make the transition into S3 on **Tuesday 19th May**. This will allow admin staff the opportunity to let you know about your course choices.

This means S1 pupils will move into S2, S2 into S3 and so on.

Below you will find details of how to access your learning. We understand that this may be tricky for some pupils, please try to do what you can. We would ask that if you need support, you should contact your class teacher or Year Head for advice. It's better to share how you are feeling than not.

New S2 pupils

New S2 pupils will continue with the same subjects. You will have the same teachers for the time being. Learning activities will continue to be shared in the same way as previously via Office365 Teams and SharePoint.

New S3 pupils

You will receive an email on Thurs 14/05 or Fri 15/05 with your subject choice information. Your learning will move forward on **Tuesday 19th May**. Please check your school email regularly as teachers and Curricular Leaders will be in touch with

important information about your new subjects. Some subjects will continue using Office 365 Sharepoint and some will choose to set up new Teams for your new courses. New Teams won't all be set up immediately, so please be patient. Work will be provided on a weekly basis via these online tools.

New S4 pupils

New S4 pupils will continue with the same subjects. You will have the same teachers for the time being. Learning activities will continue to be shared in the same way as previously via Office365 using the Teams and SharePoint.

New S5 and S6 pupils

You should have received a personal email with information related to your course choices. Please check your school email regularly as teachers and Curricular Leaders will be in touch with important information about your new subjects. Some subjects will continue using Office 365 Sharepoint and some will choose to set up new Teams for new courses. Work will be provided on a weekly basis via these online tools.
