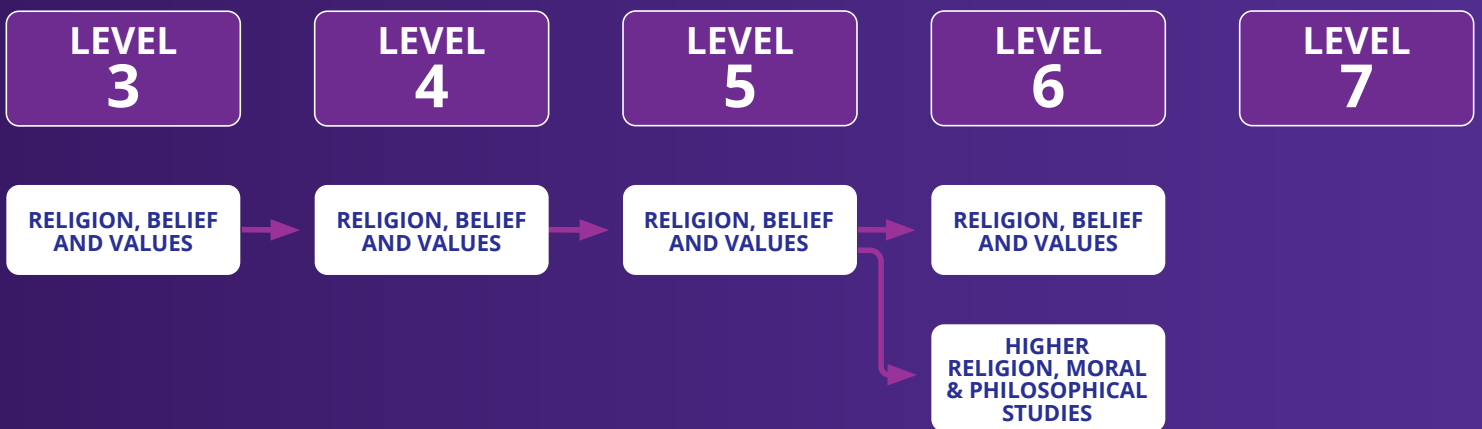

SKILLS DEVELOPED ON THIS COURSE

- Researching, analysing, evaluating, and synthesizing information to draw detailed reasoned and well-structured conclusions and presenting findings about factual and theoretical elements of religious, moral, and philosophical topics or issues.
- Identifying and responding to different ideas and viewpoints.
- Interpreting the meaning and context of sources related to world religion and explaining relevant abstract ideas.

COURSE INFORMATION RMPS allows us to learn about issues and share our own ideas and stand points on them. We will also learn what different philosophers and great thinkers believe the answers are to some of the world's toughest questions to answer.

The course has three units:

- World Religion- pupils will develop skills to explain and comment on the meaning and context of sources related to Christianity.
- Morality and Belief- pupils develop skills to explain and express reasoned views about contemporary moral questions and responses to issues such as Morality and Justice.
- Religious and Philosophical questions - Pupils examine the nature of belief including origins.

Each unit focuses on developing factual and theoretical knowledge specific to that theme.
